


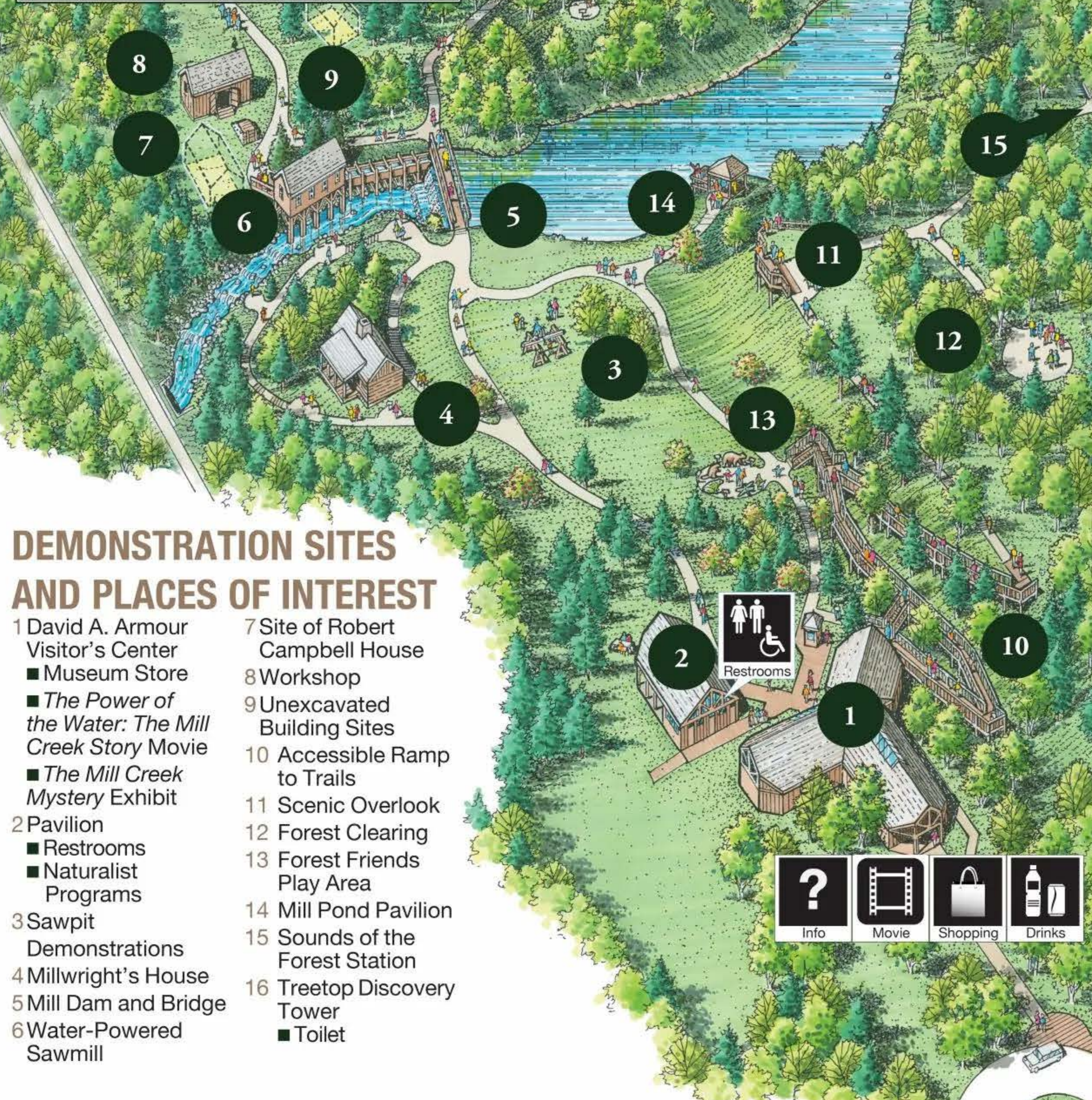


ACCESS INFORMATION FOR GUESTS WITH DISABILITIES
